Sermon: One Little "If" Can Change Your Life

Text: Romans 8:31

Thesis: Nothing Else Matters If God Is For Us.

I. If God Is For Us Then, No Weapon Formed Against You Will Prosper." (Isaiah 54:17)

A. This is what unconquerableness really is.

B. This is God's brand of justice.

II. If God Is For Us Then, He That Is In Us Is Greater Than He That Is In The World. (I John 4:4)

A. Christianity is more than a religion.

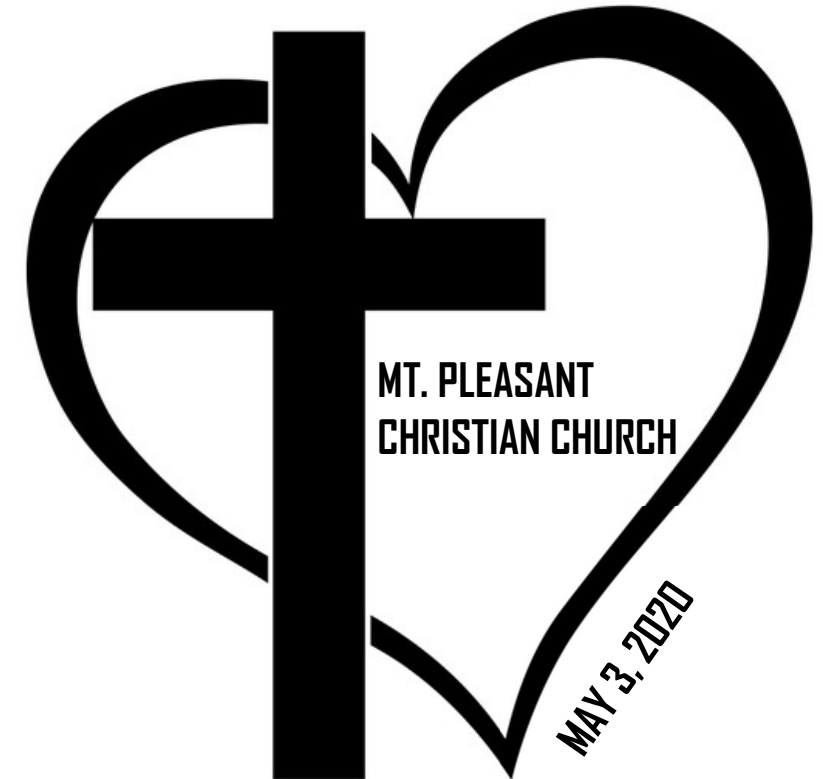
B. Paul's not the only one who speaks of overcoming.
