SERMON OUTLINE

Sermon: Growing Spiritual Kids

Text: Proverbs 22:6

Thesis: Parents Are The Greatest Spiritual Contributors.

- I. Talk To Your Kids About God.
 - A. Talking to kids about God does make an impact.
 - B. Use as many opportunities as possible.
- II. Pray And Read The Bible With Your Children.
 - A. This means setting aside times to do so.
 - B. This can lead to a practice of regular devotions.
- III. Teach Kids To Serve Others.
 - A. This too is important to faith development.
 - B. Kids need to know that service is when we are most like the Lord.
