Sermon - Convictions Are More...

Text: Romans 8:35-37

Thesis: The Threat Of The Grave Can't Change Our Core Convictions

I. Convictions Are Written In Blood, Sweat And Tears.

- A. This was not a mere statement or hypothesis.
- B. But Paul was speaking from the experience of truth.

II. Convictions Are Lessons Learned From Experiences.

- A. Things which we don't want to experience regularly.
- B. These things aren't taught in lecture halls.

III. Convictions Come At A Cost.

- A. They make our lives so much better.
- B. These are so much more than poetic ramblings.

Conclusion: So what are your convictions? Would you be willing to go to the grave for yours? Do you have something which you would stake your reputation on? Paul did this for his. And his have been embraced and adopted by many saints since the day it was first shared. I ask you to consider doing this as well. It will give you hope and change the way you view all of life, including God Himself. A true conviction is something which comes with no ifs, ands or buts.
