Absentee Ballot Completion

(To be given to person requesting absentee ballot)

- 1. Complete ballot. Ballot can be completed and returned immediately after receiving it or it can be returned at a later date prior to deadline to the designated person only. Only one ballot per set of envelopes. Place completed ballot inside the small envelope and seal it. DO NOT WRITE ANYTHING ON THE SMALL ENVELOPE!
- 2. Place small envelope (sealed) inside the larger envelope which is considered the outside envelope.
- 3. Seal outside envelope and write your name on it.
- 4. Return envelope to designated person <u>at least</u> 6 hours prior to the voting.

Please note: Once the absentee ballot is returned to the designated person, the absentee ballot will be the only vote for the eligible member. No absentee ballot will be accepted after the designated deadline.
