

Sermon: Don't Get Stuck

Text: John 4:16 -30

Thesis: The Cross Has Room For Dirty Laundry.

I. We All Have Hampers With Dirty Laundry.

- A. In other words, we all have pasts.
- B. No one in this life is without their share.

II. We All Have Things We Struggle With.

- A. These things are like stains.
- B. No one should have to struggle alone.

III. We All Have Hang-ups That Haunt Us.

- A. These are parts of our past which keep grabbing us.
- B. Jesus came with the right stuff.

Conclusion: Take note of verse 28 here. This woman was so happy about what she had heard and the second chance she'd been given that she left her water jar. But I want to say that she left more than a water jar at the well that day. She left a past which she'd been shackled to for some time. She dealt with her laundry that day with the help of the Lord. Do you have something you need to leave behind today? The foot of the cross is cluttered with dirty laundry, but there's just enough room for yours.
