Sermon: A Family Worth Joining

Text: John 1:12 & 13

Thesis: Jesus Has Made An Amazing Offer.

I. Being His Child Means He Will Love Us.

- A. The world needs more genuine love.
- B. As Creator God loves us.

II. Being His Child Means He Will Forgive Us.


- A. Every person needs forgiveness.
- B. The Creator Does Redemption even better.


III. Being His Child Means He Will Call You His Own.


- A. Man is built with the need to belong.
- B. No life is complete without Him.



Conclusion: You see the story of the woman of the well touches and speaks to us, in part, because we can see ourselves in that story. But the opportunity she was given is also offered to us all. At the well, she found out just how much she was loved and it completely stunned her. She found out just to what depths God would go to forgive and restore her. And she found that her desire to belong could be completely met by her God and Creator. Finally, someone who wanted her, just as she was. This water of life is still available.
