Sermon: Fight For Your Time With God

Text: Deuteronomy 8:3

Thesis: Prayer Is Worth Fighting For.

I. Prayer Is Accessing The Limitless Wisdom Of God.

- A. With life we are quickly overwhelmed at times.
- B. God is never stunned or overwhelmed.

II. Prayer Is An Invading Of The Impossible.

- A. Impossible is a stunning adversary.
- B. Why do we limit a limitless God?


III. Prayer Is Our Way Of Recharging, Replenishing And Restoring.



- A. In the wilderness God's people used manna for this.
- B. Today, spiritually speaking we use prayer in this capacity.


Conclusion: The key word with prayer is daily. You can't save it up, hoard it away or ever have any left over. To have access to God's wisdom you have to come daily. To invade the conquer in the land of impossible, you must come daily. To be recharged, replenished and restored, you must come to the throne room of God daily. Many things which try to keep you from this, but you must win this fight.
