Sermon: Your Prayer Voice

Text: Acts 4:23 – 31

Thesis: This Is No Time To Be Silent.

I. Elijah Found His Prayer Voice At Mount Carmel.

- A. There he confronted the prophets of Baal.
- B. He also brought an entire nation to their knees.

II. John The Baptist Found His Prayer Voice In The Wilderness.

- A. There he called Israel to repentance.
- B. He also prepared the way for Jesus' appearance.

III. Moses Found His Prayer Voice To Lead God's People Out.

- A. Moses had to go to grad school to find his prayer voice.
- B. After that Moses was enabled to stand upon to anything in prayer.

Conclusion: Now these three men had one things in common. They each found their voice in the wilderness. A wilderness will be a place where you're not so distracted that you can't hear God and have time for Him to work. I ask you, please work on finding your prayer voice. Your little niche of the world needs you. Your breakthrough could be important to changing people and converting people to Jesus.
