SERMON DUTLINE

Sermon: Unintentional Blindness

Text: Matthew 23:23 & 24 Thesis: Don't Miss The Main Event. I. The Pharisees Missed The Miracles. A. They were focused on the wrong things. B. Will we miss the working of the Lord too? II. The Pharisees Missed The Messiah. A. The rules were more important than the Lord. B. The church stumbles here too from time to time. III. The Pharisees Were Blinded By Legalism. A. They were going through the motions.

B. Will be faithful of going through the motions?

Conclusion: Friends, I spoke today about unintentional blindness for a serious reason. This is a serious threat to our spiritual vitality. We need to see that the main thing today is reaching the lost and bringing glory to the Father. These lost may have different color skin, different cultures, different backgrounds, tattoos, and even bad habits. But God sees their potential and He's called us to reach out and forth. Let's not miss the opportunities God has sent us. Don't miss the main event or the gorilla in the room.


