With regards to the upcoming **Congregational Meeting and the voting on Elders and/or Deacons**, below is important information:

For those not able to attend the Congregational Meeting on 1/26/22, you will have the opportunity to complete an **Absentee Ballot**. (to be given to the person requesting absentee ballot)

1. Complete ballot. Ballot can be completed & returned immediately after receiving it or it can be returned at a later date prior to the deadline to the designated person only. Only one ballot per set of envelopes. Place completed ballot inside the small envelope & seal it. **DO NOT WRITE ANYTHING ON THE SMALL ENVELOPE.**
2. Place small envelope (sealed) inside the larger envelope which is considered the outside envelope.
3. Seal outside envelope & write your name on it.
4. Return envelope to designated person at least 6 hours prior to the voting.

Please note: Once the absentee ballot is returned to the designated person, the absentee will be the only vote for the eligible member. No absentee ballot will be accepted after the designated deadline.

Sermon: The Human Element Of Miracles

Text: Matthew 19:26

Thesis: God Will Never Do Your Part.

I. Sometimes To Have God Part Waters We Have To Step Into The Water.

- A. Life's crossings require faith and effort.
- B. We're going to have our share of crossings too.

II. Sometimes To Have God Work We Have To Wade Into The Water Seven Times.

- A. The healings we seek also require faith and effort.
- B. Faith lets God set the terms and we bring obedience.

III. Sometimes To Have God Do The Supernatural, We Have To Do The Natural.

- A. This natural is the human element which is key to success.
- B. God will bring the supernatural.

Conclusion: Often times we need a healing, though not always physically. Sometimes we need a crossing. Getting on to something new and improved. God has the ability and help, even when the odds are stacked against us and the world claims it to be impossible. Well, I don't think anything is impossible for God.
