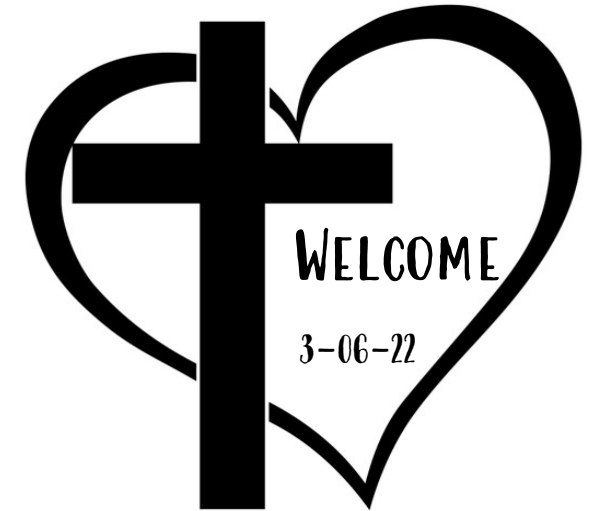

Sermon: The Baseline

Text: Psalm 74:12

Thesis: We Measure All In Light Of Salvation.

### I. Jesus Proved Lordship Over The Winds And Waves. (John 6)

A. God will do anything for an encore.

B. Sometimes God brings evidence to blow the lid off.

### II. Jesus Proved That There's More Than Meets The Eye. (John 9)

A. It takes so much more than eyes to see.

B. Sight is about eyes which work with the brain.

### III. Jesus Proved The Superior Power Of God Over Death. (John 11)

A. Just when you think you've seen it all.

B. Don't place a period where God places a comma.

**Conclusion:** And this is also why salvation is the baseline of all miracles. For it's in baptism that we are raised and summoned by the Creator of the universe to rise a new creature and glorify Him with your new life. Everything else is measured along-side this great, mighty and amazing work of God. Olive Wendell Holmes once said, "When a person's mind is stretched by a new idea, it never returns to its original dimensions." I pray that as we look more closely at miracles that our faith will be stretch and forever changed.
