Sermon: No More Wine Text: John 2:3

Thesis: Always Go To The Source Of True Help.

I. Miracles Don't Depend Your Ability To Find A Solution.

A. God doesn't need us to explain things.

B. Trust is not about word count.

II. We Only Need To Know Where To Turn.

A. There is no magic involved here.

B. It's about the who, not the how.

III. If We Seek Him First, Then He Won't Be Your Last Resort.

A. Don't wait till you need a miracle to trust.

B. God doesn't want to be just a 911 call.

Conclusion: On this day in Cana, Mary didn't scramble for a solution. She just came to Jesus and told Him of the problem. He was her first and only choice that day. Though she had never witnessed Him performing a single miracle, she knew He was God. She trusted the words which the angel delivered to her. She trusted God and placed her faith in the One who would heal the sick, calm storms and raise the dead. I believe the best of what God will do is yet to come. Do you?
