SERMON DUTLINE

What He Can Do With Next To Nothing Is Astounding

Text: John 2:5 - 8

Thesis: We Need To Observe God's Handiwork.

- I. We Grossly Underestimate God. (Ephesians 3:20)
 - A. He can do more than we ask.
- B. He can do more than we imagine.
- II. This Miracle With Water Was Merely To Show What He Can Do With Next To Nothing.
 - A. This was an object lesson for us to refer back to.
 - B. And look at all the things God has done with water.
- III. A Simple Equation Explains It All.
 - A. Miracles are not magic.
 - B. This equation used here should be closely noted.

Conclusion: Exactly how Jesus turned water into wine is a mystery. That's what makes it a true miracle. The most recent count I've seen says there are 10 to the 82 atoms in the observable universe. And yet every one of them traces its origin back to for words, "Let there be light." Just think of all God can do with all their various combination. It's definitely more than we can imagine.
