## SERMON OUTLINE

### Sermon: The Common Ground Of Each Miracle

**Text:** John 4:46

**Thesis:** There’s A Reason They’re Called Miracles

#### I. Jesus Has Mastery And Majesty At The Molecular Level.

- A. He’s the catalyst for any and all transformation.
- B. He’s best at transforming sinners into saints.

#### II. Every Single Atom Traces Its Origin Back To Four Words.

- A. These four words were “Let there be light.”
- B. God did all this with His voice.

#### III. God Created And Controls All Atoms.

- A. There so much He can do with and through them.
- B. The Scripture is full of these examples.

**Conclusion:** The common ground for every miracle is, simply put, God. Physicists have quantified four fundamental forces: gravitational, electromagnetic, strong nuclear and weak nuclear. But quantum physicists have introduced a fifth force that governs the other four together. And I’d say it’s God who holds all of this together, since the creation of the universe. And that alone is why I believe in miracles.
