**Sermon: Don’t Be Afraid To Crash The Party**

**Text: Matthew 7:7 & 8**

**Thesis: Show God You’re Serious.**

**I. That’s What The Woman With The Issue Of Blood did. (Matthew 9:20)**

A. Looking at this story it seems that she wasn’t in the original script.

B. Sometimes effort can be the difference.

**II. That’s What The Woman With the Alabaster Jar Of Perfume Did. (Luke 7)**

B. Nothing was going to keep her from the presence of Jesus.
