Text: John 5:1 – 7

Thesis: Let Jesus Be Your Cure.

I. The Invalid's Greatest Handicap Was Mental.

- A. We often miss the whole point.

Conclusion: Friends we're not going to see great moves of God by sitting at the edge of the pool. Or by waiting for it to stir. You can decide all you want. You can go to counseling and it may help. You can decide to think deeply and reason through things, but until Jesus gets involved, little change may be seen. Why not try what works and then look for big things, hopefully and with expectation.
