Thesis: Great Things Happen When We Partner Up With God.

- I. Naaman Had To Dip In The Jordan Seven Times. (2 Kings 5)
- A. Naaman had much to do.
- B. Don't let pride, doubt or logical thinking kill your miracle.
- II. The Woman With The Issue Of Blood Had To Fight The Crowds. (Luke 8:42 48)
