Sermon: In Order To Get Your Miracle

Text: Acts 13:38 – 41

Thesis: Don't Be Afraid Of Doing Something Different.

I. God May Do Something Unprecedented.

A. There's a first time for everything.

Conclusion: In Ephesians 3:20 this is called "more than we ask or even imagine." Here in our passage it's called "that you would never believe, even if someone told you." But feel free to call it what you will. The bottom line is to expect to go against everything you thought, imagined or hoped. He will move Heaven and earth for His children. And, by the way, He's done that too.
