SERMON

Sermon: The Miracle Of Daily Bread Matthew 6:11

Thesis: God Desires To Keep Us Close.

I. We Don't Want To Depend On Him On A Daily Basis.

- A. We want anything but daily.
B. That's when God has us right where he wants us.

II. Spiritual Maturity Is Not Self-sufficiency.

- A. No one is arguing against the need for maturity in the church.
B. We're never outgrow our need for God.

III. God Puts Us In Situations Where Enough Isn't Enough.

- A. Getting a miracle requires the need of one.
B. Sometimes enough isn't enough at all.

Conclusion: I want to need God more, not less. I want to rely on Him daily, not weekly, monthly or yearly. I want Him to draw close to me and for me to draw close to Him. May I be clay in His hands for His good use to bring Him glory and honor. And may I be always expectant of the miracles He wants to bring in my life. And I pray you will be the same way.
