### SERMON

**Sermon: The Difference Between 0 And 153** 

Text: John 21:5 - 11

Thesis: Ninety Inches Can Make All The Difference.

I. Miracles Don't Just Happen When We Believe God For Big Things.

- A. Make note of all the little things He does.
- B. Our faith in the little things enables the big things.
- II. Miracles Happen When We Obey God In The Little Things.
  - A. God will not do our part.
  - B. We definitely can't do His part.
- III. When We Do Little Things Like They Are Big Things, God Will Do Big Things Like They Are Little Things.
  - A. Nothing, we do for God is insignificant.
  - B. God sees nothing as big.

Conclusion: Mark Batterson observed that it appeared that the miracles involving fish or fishing were places where the Apostles actually thought they knew more than Jesus, who was a carpenter by trade. They may have never said it, but there's a good chance they thought it. These men were practically born on a boat in the Sea of Galilee. This was their domain and their strong suit. But you know this is often the place where it is hardest to trust God. It's here that we tend to trust our God given gifts instead of the One who blessed us with them. Ninety inches could be all the difference.
