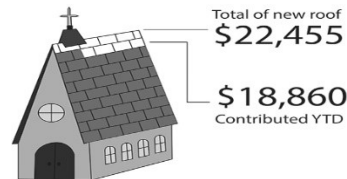

Sermon: There Are Two Groups

Text: Matthew 14:26 - 31

Thesis: Critics Aren't Water Walkers.

I. Those Who Criticize Water Walkers Typically Do So From Comfortable Seats.

- A. Criticism has 20/20 vision.
- B. Water Walkers aren't in it for the comfort.

II. The More You Accomplish For The Kingdom Of God, The Less Critical You Become.
