SERMON

Sermon: Identify The Voice

Text: Revelation 12:10 & 11

Thesis: Carefully Choose The Voice You’ll Listen.

I. Many Of Us Are Deafened By The Negative Self-talk.

A. This is what we call “off-key.”

B. Be a powerful ally to yourself.

II. Many Of Us Have Heard Only the Voice Of Criticism.

A. Criticism is always a sour note.

B. Then there is chronic criticism.

III. Many Of Us Have Heard The Enemy’s Voice Of Condemnation.

A. He’s called the accuser for a reason.

B. Consider a few things.

Conclusion: God wants us to be able to hear His voice clearly. He is trying to get and keep the attention of the whole world. It’s obvious that our world is cluttered with voices and influences. We need to silence or drown out these voices. If we do not, we will eventually become deaf to that which God wants us to hear. Every day I look and see people who can’t hear the song of salvation, the offer which God is making to them. God’s orchestra is playing for you, for me and everyone. Let’s hear His voice of truth, love and forgiveness.
