Sermon: Our Songs of Deliverance

Text: Psalm 32:7; Isaiah 54:17

Thesis: We Shall Overcome

I. These Songs Are Powerful Enough To Break Any Bondage.

- A. God is a great liberator.
- B. He is still breaking people free.

II. These Songs Are Powerful Enough To Overcome Any Addiction.

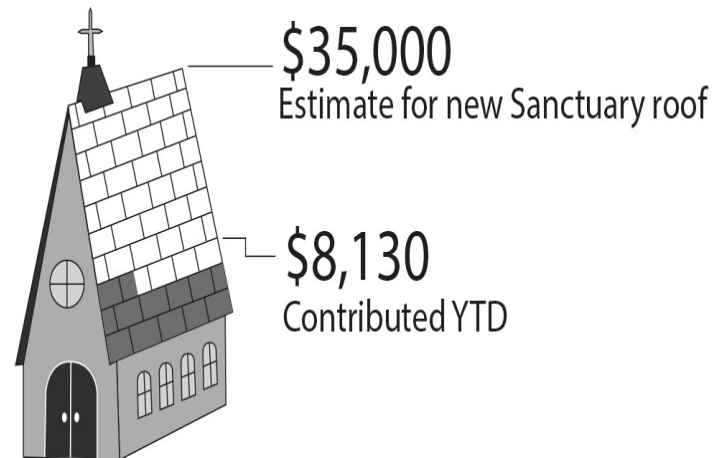
ANNOUNCEMENTS 1/29/23
