Sermon: His Voice Of Love

Text: Deuteronomy 30:19 & 20; Psalm 143:8

Thesis: The Voice Of Scripture Is Where It All Begins.

I. The Voice Of God Is All Powerful.

- A. He says it and it happens.
- B. No power or force can stand up to His power.

II. The Voice Of God Is All Loving.

- A. David makes note of God’s unfailing love. (Ps. 143:8)
- B. Remember God is love.

III. God’s First Language Is Scripture.

- A. This is the Rosetta stone to all of God’s languages.
- B. There are six other languages.

Conclusion: The words of Deuteronomy 30:20 were given to God’s people to live by in the Promised Land. But these words are clear advice given in love by God to us. “Love the Lord your God, listen to his voice, and hold fast to him.” His voice is important to all of us finishing well. Let’s listen as intently as Mary did at the feet of Jesus.
