Sermon: God Is With Us All The Way

Text: Exodus 3:13 – 15

Thesis: We Are Never Without God.

I. God's Name Is Sacred To Pronounce, Yet It's Whispered With Each Breath.

- A. God's name is completely sacred.
- B. Yet, everyone whispers God's name.

II. God's Name Is Our First Word, Last Word And Every Word In Between.

- A. It's truly a word of significance.
- B. A word and presence which is with us always.

III. God Is As Close As Every Breath We Breathe.

- A. There is no place He is not.
- B. We are never far from Him and His presence.

Conclusion: This passage highlights the name of our great and wonderful God. But remember why these words were said to Moses. They were given to equip and inspire Him to service. And therefore, I've shared with you today. I want to be inspired and I want to inspire you to action. I want you to face your daily life knowing that as you breath you are speaking His name. And know He is there, always waiting to help.
