Sermon: It Can Happen Anywhere

Text: Job 26:13 & 14

Thesis: God Has A Word For Us All.

I. Moses’ Whispering Spot Was At The Burning Bush. (Exodus 3)

A. Curiosity drew Moses to this spot.

B. Moses is given a task to do on behalf of God.

II. Joshua’s Whispering Spot Was At Gilgal. (Joshua 5)

A. This will be an important place forever.

B. Joshua is prepared and strengthen for the task ahead.

III. Gideon’s Whispering Spot Was At The Oak Tree in Ophrah.

A. God always beat us to the meeting place.

B. He’s going to take Gideon from victim to victor.

Conclusion: We have a bad habit of telling God how big our troubles and struggles are. We need to tell our struggles how big our God is. Today, we have looked at three more times when characters came to their whispering spot and God spoke to them in their own unique way. Each got a message which empowered them to step out and do something God wanted them to do.
