Sermon: Sin Prevention Text: Psalm 119:11

Thesis: Nothing Works Better Than The Word.

I. The Word Lasts Longer Than The Longest Memory.

- A. Man has a forgetting problem.
- B. God's Word is better than the best of memories.

II. The Word Is Stronger Than The Strongest Imagination.

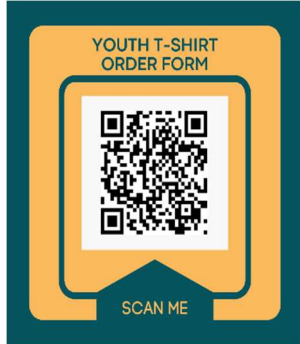
