Text: Acts 16:6 - 10

Thesis: God Can Speak Through A Closed Door.

I. God Closes Doors To Protect Us.

A. We don't always choose the best path.

B. God will frequently send us on what appears to be a detour.

II. God Closes Doors To Redirect Us.

**Conclusion:** Being hindered from going in one direction might be a little discouraging. Having it happen again, so quickly might really play on one's mind. But God didn't leave Paul hanging for very long. That evening God sent Paul a dream of a man beckoning them to Macedonia. And this led Paul to a divine appointment which no one saw coming. This is the hope we have when we move at the Lord's direction. Let's trust the Lord when He closes a door and see it as a blessing.
