### **Using Stress To Our Advantage**

James 1:2 - 6

Thesis: Stress Doesn't Have To Be Viewed Negatively.

- I. Stress May Be God's Way Of Telling Us Something Is Out Of Balance.
  - A. Life works best when balanced.
  - B. Through stress God is saying something is off.
- II. Stress Can Be A Warning Signal And A Useful Tool.
  - A. God loves us enough to give us warning signals.
  - B. When we're stressed maybe He's warning us.
- III. Learning To Deal With Stress Can Result In Longer, Happier and Healthier Lives.
  - A. James was calling these saints to action.
- B. There was better life, than what they were currently experiencing.

Conclusion: May we look at stress differently after today. May we hear the warnings which stress can often bring forth from God. When we find ourselves out of balance, we will go in faith to the One who can readjust us. May He answer of prayers and get our lives back on track and within the lanes of His will. May we use that which can weaken and destroy us to the glory of a loving and living God.
