Thesis: True Faith Can Trump Secularism.

I. These Generations Buy Into The Lies About Significance.

- A. They seek peace and purpose through people and possessions.
- B. They seek peace and purpose through position and power.

II. These Generations Trade Prosperity For Serious IIIs.

- A. The world's prosperity does not deliver on it's promises.
 - B. Prosperity can bring stress and ills as well.

III. These Generations Need A Glimpse Of True Faith.

- A. They need to see more than those "considering" religion.
- B. No one wants something which is worthless and unusable.

Conclusion: In John 10:10 Jesus says, "I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full." He did not come to leave us on empty. But He can't fill our tank till we stop and give Him access. He can't till we give His truth a real try. Nothing gives our lives peace and purpose like the Creator. Prosperity is a truly poor substitute for all the blessings God has written your name on. So focus your life and look closely at what real faith is, what is does and what it looks like. True Christianity is more than useful and worthwhile. It is essential to possess eternity.
