Background

Dewayne became a Christian on April 30, 1975. He married Jackie (Cole) Liebrandt September 5, 1976. They have two children, April and Daniel. Dewayne served in his home church as a Deacon and was also on the Missions Committee. In June 1987, Dewayne left his job at GM and joined NBCM. He attended Roanoke Bible College from 1987-1989 where he received his AB Degree in Deaf Ministries. He was ordained and the family moved to Thailand in 1989. Dewayne and Jackie's ministry calling is to, "Take the Gospel of Christ to the deaf of the world". Dewayne has learned different Sign Languages as well as spoken Thai. He has worked with the deaf in 13 countries. The Liebrandts have a broad range of ministry outreaches to the deaf in Thailand and Colombia such as: deaf churches, church camps, video productions, short-term ministry programs, sign language classes, and job training. They have a hands-on ministry, with a world-wide calling, which is focused on one deaf person at a time. Dewayne is currently helping preach at Liberty Christian Church where they have worked to begin a deaf ministry.
