Sermon: Give Careful Thought Text: Haggai 1:5 Thesis: You Are As You Think.

I. Impure Thinking Produces Inconsistent Living.

A. Man needs a regular spiritual checkup.
B. When our walk is inconsistent, we need to find a place to turn around.
II. Those Lacking Virtue In Their Thinking Cannot Act Decently.
A. Anyone put on an act for a while.
B. Our hearts and minds are like wells.

III. Holy Living Follows Holy Thinking.

A. We need to have a pure heart and mind.B. Building the Church needs to be our priority.

Conclusion: I hope you didn't have to struggle too hard for that answer. He desires to reside in the heart of mankind. We know this because Jesus was our Immanuel, or God with us. We know because He promised He would pour out His Spirit upon all men in Joel. Furthermore, we saw that fulfilled on the Day of Pentecost when 3,000 responded to the first gospel sermon. Your body is the Temple of the Holy Spirit (I Cor. 6:19) and that's where He wants to reside. But He will not reside in a desecrated temple. Remember His warning to the 7 churches in Revelation. In 2:5 He says, "Repent and do the things you did at first. If you do not repent, I will come to you and remove your lampstand from its place."
