SERMON

Confrontation With Sinful Choices

Genesis 3:9-12

Thesis: We Need A Change.

I. The First Mistake Was a Refusal To Confess.

- A. No matter what you call it, Adam was caught.
- B. The best thing to do when we’ve sinned is to come

clean.

II. The Second Mistake Was Adam Didn’t Actively
Seek God’s Forgiveness.

- A. This is the mistake of the world.
- B. Forgiveness is one of the best things ever.

III. The Third Mistake Was Adam Blamed Others.

- A. This is avoidance at it’s worse.
- B. It’s easy to see that things haven’t changed much.

Conclusion: Man will continue to make bad and sinful choices in his life. But God can and will forgive us. That can only happen when we humble ourselves and confess our sins. Then seek God’s forgiveness sincerely and make good on your new chance. And always accept your responsibility in any failures you make in life. You won’t learn from the mistake and grow past it if you refuse to do so. Being confronted with the truth of our sin could be the first step to making things right with God and others.
