I Thessalonians 5:16 -18

Thesis: Be Thankful, No Matter What.

I. We Should Give Thanks For God's Grace. (I Corinthians 1:4)

A. Not just for what's been given us, but to others as well.

B. There's nothing wrong with being grateful for grace's work in us either.

II. We Should Give Thanks For God's Word. (I Thessalonians 2:13)

A. Paul was thankful for the Word's work.

III. We Should Give Thanks For The Maturity And Love Of Other Believers. (2 Thessalonians 1:3)
