SERMON

The Supernatural Elements Surrounding Jesus' Death

Matthew 27:50-53

Thesis: The Resurrection Continues to Change Lives

I. The First Supernatural Event Was Jesus' Submission To Death.

- A. This one is often overlooked.
- B. Submission has gotten a bad reputation.

II. The Next Supernatural Event Was The Tearing Of The Temple Curtain From Top To Bottom.

- A. This curtain was a significant part of the Temple.
- B. God's people now have a "new and living way."

III. The Next Supernatural Events Were An Earthquake, Tombs Opened, And The Resurrection Of Saints.

- A. This was no ordinary earthquake.
- B. The opened tombs gave forth their dead.

Conclusion: Matthew doesn't tell us what happened after that. We don't know whether these dead went back to the grave or whether they ascended to Heaven. But it's a fact that Jesus is still raising people to the newness of life through the watery grave of immersion. Each time one is baptized they bear witness of the power of God to raise the dead and to give one a new lease on life. And if you need that today, then now is your time. I challenge you to come forth and give Christ your life.

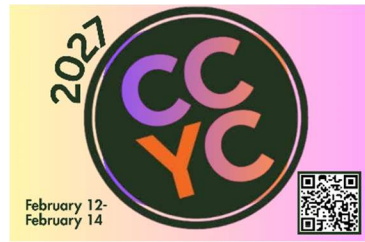

We are excited to announce that our 2026 VBS Mission will be Operation Christmas Child. We will raise money at VBS to help cover the cost of shipping for 100 boxes, and we will have a church wide packing day on Saturday, October 11th. Time is TBA. We are announcing our missions project early this year because it's a great idea to shop year-round for Operation Christmas Child in the clearance sections and after-season sales. Keep an eye out for "WOW" toys and smaller filler toys, barbies, durable games (travel sets that come in metal tins), clothing items, utensil sets, kids' plates/bowls/cups, school supplies, good quality wash cloths, hair accessories, combs, flip flops/shoes, toothbrushes, jump ropes, small stuffed animals, and more! There's a table set up in the foyer to leave items. We will keep track of collected items in a spreadsheet and then move items to a storage room until it's time to pack. Throughout the next few months, we will also provide updates on items that are no longer needed. Most items will be unpackaged to help take up less space in boxes AND to reduce waste and trash in the counties where they are sent. Multi-pack items will be divided among multiple boxes.

We plan to pack 10 boxes for girls ages 2-4, 10 boxes for boys ages 2-4, 20 boxes for boys ages 5-9, 20 boxes for girls ages 5-9, 20 boxes for girls ages 10-14, and 20 boxes for boys ages 10-14. Please pray over these boxes, the items that we will purchase, and the children that will receive each one.
