Thesis: We Need To Do Our Part Well.

I. Let's Consider The First Element Of This Equation, High Potency.

- A. Full revelation gives us our highest potential.
B. Full access to the lost gives us great potential.

II. The Next Element Of The Equation Is Close Proximity.

- A. Salvation and deliverance was and is nearer.
B. Technology has brought the truth closer to men too.

III. The Final Element Of The Equation Is Clear Communication.

- A. Paul started by giving a clear message to those who would be sharing the gospel.
B. The world needs a clear, unobstructed message of truth and hope.

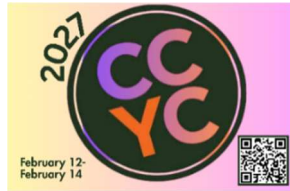
