Thesis: Now Is No Time To Fall Silent.

I. Somebody Must Tell Them Who God Is.

- A. Most people do not really know God.
- B. We're living in a very Godless world.

II. Somebody Needs To Describe The Type Of Damage Sin Causes.

- A. Sin is nothing to take lightly.
- B. There are always consequences to sinful choices.

III. Somebody Needs To Explain How We Each Need Forgiveness.

- A. All flesh covered creatures have sinned and need forgiveness.
- B. God can and will give forgiveness.

Conclusion: Spreading the gospel doesn't just happen on its own. Someone has to go, share and often explain. This explanation will often introduce a person to God as He really is. It will also include letting a person see the true damage sin will bring in one's life and eternity. And finally, it will include a clear view of how each of us, no matter how good, needs the forgiveness of our eternal and merciful God. Let's be contagious.

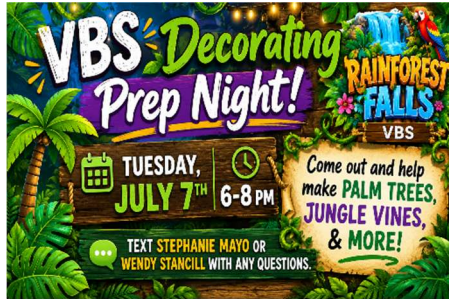
