SERMON

ARE WE TAKING IT SERIOUSLY? Matthew 28:18-20
THESIS: We Are Affecting Eternity.

I. This Is A Divine Imperative.

- A. It's an imperative not to be ignored.
- B. This is one of the most important things shared with the church.

II. This Is Given By God.

- A. This not one of man's good ideas.
- B. This is a command from God Himself.

III. This Is For The Sake Of Lost People.

- A. The lost matter to the Father.
- B. The degree of heed we give to the Great Commission has a direct bearing on the outcome.

Conclusion: The Great Commission is to be taken as seriously as anything in the life of a Christian. It's not a suggestion or a task for only a few within the church. It's not for the special forces of any congregation, but for all within the Lord's Army. Let's not treat it as the Great Omission. This is a God ordained opportunity for each saint to directly be involved with eternal affairs. We can change the eternal destiny of others for God.

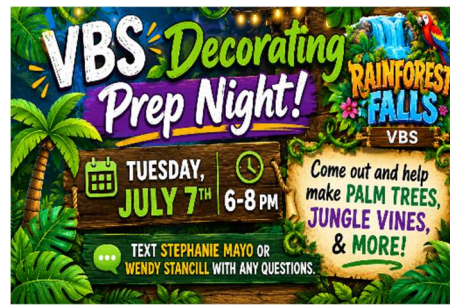
