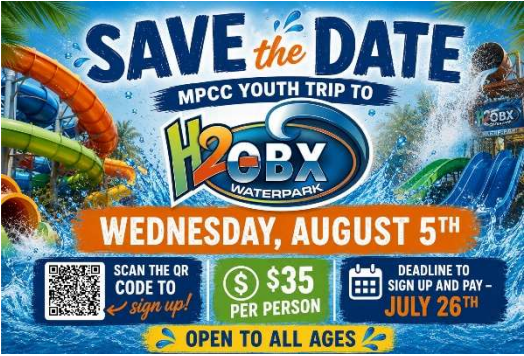

SERMON

THE PRICE ACTS 20:28 Sin Bares A High Cost

I. Sin Damages The Relationship Between Man And God.

A. Paul appeals to these men as saints and as leaders.

B. We are our brothers’ keepers.

II. Jesus Took The Bill And Paid the Death Penalty.

A. Sin runs up a high debt before God.

B. Jesus picked up the check.

III. Jesus Came In Person And Died In Our Place.

A. Only one sacrifice was good and sufficient enough.

B. Jesus took our place.

Conclusion: Paul was reminding these Christians and leaders of their responsibility as members of the Lord’s church. I want to lovingly and gently do the same. You are meant to live with the Creator of the universe for all eternity. This is made possible by the death of Jesus, God’s Son. You then we made to be contagious with the gospel and share it everywhere you go. Let’s do just that.
