SERMON

MAKING SENSE OF EVIL

Colossians 1:21-23

Thesis: We Have The Truth About Evil

I. Evil Is Real And Has No Part With God.

- A. Paul speaks of evil behavior here in our passage.
- B. He made it clear that man is on dangerous ground.

II. Evil Is Against The Standards Of God And Is Wrong.

- A. Evil brings accusations from Satan.
- B. Evil leaves it's mark on all those who partake.

III. We Are Accountable For The Evil We Commit.

- A. We are called to continue "in our faith."
- B. We are called to "not be moved from the hope."

Conclusion: Whether we know or acknowledge it, evil is real. The Bible speaks of it often and God is the Author of it and He cannot lie. (Titus 1:2) Those having evil have no place with God, but they are not without hope. God sent His One and only Son to this earth to die to give them a chance to be restored to Him. Now rest your faith in Him and grow in your faith. This is the way of the contagious Christian.
